# Prevention and Early Intervention Research Initiative

- Funded by Atlantic Philanthropies as a legacy project
- 14 collections of evaluation data in ISSDA and IQDA
- Grants for secondary analysis of data 2017-18

Essentially a project to **preserve** all the knowledge generated about PEI sixteen years (2002 – 2018)

...which is of significance beyond Ireland

## Why? They're already online?

- Reports get buried on website
- Eventually they get lost
- URL link to report break
- When website is redone report is shed because nobody remembers what it is
- The context gets lost – nobody remembers what bits really matter

# What do I want to do

- Put all of the **public facing reports** together in a single location in the Digital Repository of Ireland
- Forever more they will be freely available to view and download
- Permanently accessible no matter what happens on the NGO website
- You'll be able to find the right report (context will be captured)

# What I need from you

- If your organisation is the copyright holder of a report I will be in touch this month to request your permission to put a copy of the report in the digital library
- A single sentence saying 'yes you can include my report' in an email will suffice
- Organisation will be **fully credited** as the copyright owner in the online collection – logos can be included in the online library



# Output 2: Index of measures

An online resource where you can search for the right measurement tool (survey) for your research



# Searchable database of 200+ validated measures

- Provides a detailed description of each measure allowing user to find and assess the suitability of a measure for their research needs
- Will list the Irish studies that have used each measure – link to report
- Will list the Irish studies where data are publicly available – link to data in archive



# Output 3: Research Data Management guide

Online guidance on how to collect and store data so that it can be used more than once by your research team and by others



# RDM is best practice in data collection and storage

- What to consider when you are gathering data / commissioning research
- Based on international best practice
- Real life case studies from Irish projects
- May act as a check list of key issues for funders and applicants for funding
